On 03-29-2014 at approximately 0115 Police were on detail at 1137 Broad Street (Adas Creation). While Police were on detail, Police observed two subjects exchanging words with one another. Police did advise security that there might be a possible problem. Within two minutes there were several subjects fighting in the upstairs room. Police then observed security assisting an unknown subject laying on the floor who was unconscious. At that time Police called for another Police unit and rescue. Several minutes later he became conscious and his brother was helping him outside. On the way outside the subjects brother continued yelling at others and attempting to fight with them. Police had to tell the subject to leave several times. His brother would not cooperate with Police while trying to gather information about the incident. He refused rescue and left the scene.
