Narrative of Incident: In Re: 14-21263

On Sunday, March 09, 2014, at approximately 0250 hrs, after clearing the Ada's Creations night club crowd from the perimeter of the club, Ptlm. Garcia observed a large disturbance at the intersections of Sassafras St. and Broad St., with approximately 15 to 20 male subjects fighting. Ptlm. Garcia aird the disturbance and started walking towards the fighting crowd. At one point, Ptlm. Garcia observed what appeared to be about 5 or 6 males trying to assault a single male. At that point, Ptlm. Garcia took out his department-issued expandable baton, and his department-issued OC spray. While yelling loud verbal commands for the subjects to stop fighting, they looked at Ptlm. Garcia but then kept assaulting the single individual. At that time, Ptlm. Garcia sprayed each of the assailants with OC spray, causing them to break away from the assault, but others joined in on the melee. Ptlm. Garcia went to spray a group of four males and while spraying those males fighting, Ptlm. Garcia was pushed from behind and onto the back of one of the males fighting. This caused Ptlm. Garcia to accidentally spray his face with the OC Spray. At the same time, other officers from districts 2 and 3 were arriving and the crowds started dispersing, running away from the scene. No arrests were made since the ones fighting and the on-lookers all fled the scene. There were no complainants and no injuries reported. An AIR report was filled out by Ptlm. Garcia. END OF STATEMENT
