For the purposes of this public records request, a "violation" refers to an individual citation to the registered owner or lessee of a vehicle for speeding in a school zone, as captured by the automated school-zone-speed-enforcement system maintained by the City of Providence in accordance with RIGL § 31-41.3 at any time from October 1, 2017 up to and including today. The "recipient" refers to the person who was sent a summons in connection with each individual violation in accordance with RIGL § 31-41.3-8.

I request an electronic database that contains the following information for each individual violation: the date and time of the violation, the school zone of the violation, and the zip code (or, if available, zip+4 code) of the recipient's mailing address. The database should be a text file in CSV (comma-separated-value) or equivalent format.

Under RIGL § 38-2-3(h), the City of Providence must supply the requested electronic data in the format requested unless it can show that it would be "unduly burdened in providing such data." Since the City is required by RIGL § 31-41.3-4 to maintain an electronic database of individual violations, the release of the requested data should be no more than a trivial exercise of creating an extract
