# Complaint to the Rhode Island Ethics Commission Against Anthony E. Simon for Violation of R.I.G.L. § 36-14-16(a) Complainant: Johanna Harris

1. This is a formal complaint against Anthony E. (Tony) Simon, Chief of Staff, City of Providence, for violation of the Rhode Island Code of Ethics, specifically for failure to file a timely financial disclosure for the year 2014, as mandated by R.I.G.L. § 36-14-16(a).

#### **Relevant Statutory Provisions and Commission Regulations**

2. R.I.G.L. § 36-14-16(a), as amended, states in pertinent part:

On or before the last Friday in April of each year, the following officials and employees subject to this code of ethics shall file with the commission a financial statement complying with the requirements of this chapter. ... (5) All municipal appointed officials whose official duties and responsibilities include exercising decision-making authority over the expenditure of more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) in public funds in any fiscal or calendar year, ... (Emphases added.)

3. R.I.G.L. § 36-14-2(9) defines a "municipal appointed official" as "any officer or member of a ... municipal agency as defined herein ... who is appointed by or through the ... highest official of ... municipal government." R.I.G.L. § 36-14-2(8)(ii) defines a "municipal agency" broadly to include any "department, division, agency, commission, board, office, bureau, authority, quasi-public authority..."

4. Commission Regulation 1002(a)(2) states:

If the Complaint contains no defect as to form, it shall be reviewed by the Executive Director or designee to determine whether or not the Complaint alleges facts sufficient to constitute a knowing and willful violation of the Code of Ethics, who *shall* forward the Complaint to the Commission for review at an initial determination. (Emphasis added.)

#### Allegations

5. Anthony E. (Tony) Simon is Chief of Staff of the City of Providence. Mayor Jorge O. Elorza appointed Mr. Simon to this post on December 29, 2014. (Exhibit #1, at 6) Mr. Simon is a municipal appointed official within the meaning of R.I.G.L. § 36-14-2(9).

6. According to official documents issued by the City of Providence, the office of the Chief of Staff has major decision-making authority over 17 offices within the City's organizational hierarchy, including the two Deputy Chiefs of Staff, Policy Director, Chief Innovation Officer, and Communications Director. (Exhibit #2) These departments collectively have authorized budgetary expenditures in the millions of dollars annually. Accordingly, Mr. Simon's official duties and responsibilities include exercising decision-making authority over the expenditure of more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) in public funds in any fiscal or calendar year.

7. In an April 17, 2015 submission of the names of public officials who were required to file financial disclosures for the calendar year 2014, Providence Municipal Integrity Officer Kathryn Sabatini explicitly listed Mr. Simon's name and title. (Exhibit #1, at 6) In a cover email to Ethics Commission Administrative Officer Michelle Berg, attorney Sabatini wrote, "As we discussed, I wanted to send along by email additional City of Providence officials who should be filing financial disclosure forms." (Exhibit #1, at 1) On the same day, Ms. Berg responded, "I have quickly reviewed your attachments and it looks as though all of the relevant information is there. I hope you don't mind however that I will have to wait until the week of the 27th to take action on adding these filers." (Exhibit #1, at 1)

8. In the City's subsequent November 13, 2015 submission of the names of public officials who were required to file financial disclosures for the calendar year 2014, Mr. Simon's name and title continued to appear. (Exhibit #3) In a cover email addressed to Commission Staff Attorney Jason Gramitt, Ms. Sabatini stated, "Please see attached. We believe that the individuals on the list should be filing." (Exhibit #3, at 1)

9. After a November 24, 2015 meeting between Gramitt, Berg and Sabatini, Mr. Simon's name was improperly dropped without explanation from the list of required filers. (Exhibit #4)

10. On November 30, 2015, Ms. Berg wrote to Ms. Sabatini, "No letters have gone out... I am awaiting final word from you as to whether all folks left on the list have *major decision-making authority over \$50,000.*" (Exhibit #5. Emphasis added.)

11. On January 7, 2016, I wrote the Mr. Gramitt, contending that the Code of Ethics in fact required Mr. Simon to file a financial disclosure. I noted, in particular, "In the event that I file a formal complaint to the Ethics Commission alleging that certain individuals on the Mayor's Staff have violated R.I.G.L. § 36-14-16(a)(5), I trust that the Executive Director, acting in accordance with Commission Regulation 1002(a)(2), will forward my complaint to the Commission for review rather than attempt to unilaterally dismiss the complaint before it is properly considered by the Commission." (Exhibit #6, at 2)

12. By the afternoon of January 7, 2016, Gramitt, Berg and Sabatini had arranged for Mr. Simon's voluntary filing. (Exhibit #7)

13. Mr. Simon filed a "voluntary" disclosure on January 8, 2016. (Exhibit #8)

14. Mr. Simon did not file a financial disclosure for the year 2014 by the April 24,2015 deadline.

15. Mr. Simon's filing a "voluntary" disclosure on January 8, 2016 does not constitute compliance with R.I.G.L. § 36-14-16(a). If Mr. Simon's "voluntary" disclosure constituted compliance, then every other official covered by R.I.G.L. § 36-14-16(a) could similarly exercise his own discretion to "voluntarily" file from one year to the next without adhering to the deadline specified in the statute.

16. Pat assertions that the legislature in 2004 wanted to reduce the number of municipal employees subject to the financial disclosure requirement do not nullify section (5) of R.I.G.L. § 36-14-16(a) or somehow relieve Mr. Simon from his obligation to comply with the plain language of the statute.

17. Inasmuch as this complaint alleges facts sufficient to constitute a knowing and willful violation of the Code of Ethics, the Executive Director is required under Commission Regulation 1002(a)(2) to forward this complaint to the Commission for its review. The Executive Director has no discretion to unilaterally dismiss this complaint before it is properly considered by the Commission.






City of Providence, Executive Administration Organizational Chart

### RE: Financial Disclosure Requirements of Individuals on the Mayor's Staff, City of Providence, under R.I.G.L. § 36-14-16

Dear Mr. Gramitt,

Thank you for email response of January 6, 2016. I respectfully disagree with the staff's conclusions, as articulated in your email message.

According to R.I.G.L. § 36-14-16(a)(5), financial disclosure is required of "all *municipal* appointed officials whose official duties and responsibilities include exercising decision-making authority over the expenditure of more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) in public funds in any fiscal or calendar year." (Emphasis added.) R.I.G.L. § 36-14-2(9) defines a "municipal appointed official" as "any officer or member of a … municipal agency as defined herein … who is appointed by or through the … highest official of … municipal government." R.I.G.L. § 36-14-2(8)(ii) defines a "municipal agency" broadly to include any "department, division, agency, commission, board, office, bureau, authority, quasi-public authority..."

Mr. Brett Smiley was appointed by Mayor Elorza as the Chief Operating Officer of the City of Providence. He was also appointed by Mayor Elorza as a member of the Providence Economic Development Partnership (PEDP). Mr. Smiley currently serves as Chairman of the Board of Directors and Chairman of the Loan Committee of the PEDP. A perusal of the minutes of the PEDP's regular twice monthly meetings shows numerous individual loan approvals in excess of \$50,000.

Is the Ethics Commission staff contending that Mr. Smiley is not an appointed municipal official who exercises decision-making authority over at least \$50,000 in any given year? If not, what specific investigations has the staff performed in Mr. Smiley's case to make such a determination?

Mr. Anthony E. (Tony) Simon is the Chief of Staff in Mayor Elorza's administration. In November 2014, upon Mayor-Elect Elorza's announcement of his appointment, Mr. Simon issued the following press statement: "Mayor-elect Elorza's fresh vision and new ideas for Providence are inspirational and I look forward to helping him Jason Gramitt January 7, 2016 Page 2

put together and *manage* a diverse, energetic and talented team to serve the residents of our city and deliver on the promise of his administration." (Emphasis added.) According to the City's Budget for the Fiscal Year 2016, the Mayor's Office has budgeted expenditures of over \$1.4 million for base salaries, not counting pension, FICA or medical benefits. Other budgeted items in the Mayor's Office (Department 101-101) total over \$200,000.

Is the Ethics Commission staff contending that Mr. Simon is not an appointed municipal official who exercises decision-making authority over at least \$50,000 in any given year? If not, what specific investigations has the staff performed in Mr. Simon's case to make such a determination?

In the event that I file a formal complaint to the Ethics Commission alleging that certain individuals on the Mayor's Staff have violated R.I.G.L. § 36-14-16(a)(5), I trust that the Executive Director, acting in accordance with Commission Regulation 1002(a)(2), will forward my complaint to the Commission for review rather than attempt to unilaterally dismiss the complaint before it is properly considered by the Commission.
